### Areas of specialisation

#### Regulatory Proceedings

John appears in disciplinary hearings as an advocate, including most recently *McDonnell v Chief Constable of Kent* - a police disciplinary matter in the Police Appeal Tribunal. He also has extensive experience in chairing regulatory and tribunal hearings.

#### Crime

John has acted as a defence advocate for over 25 years. He specialises in criminal law as both junior and leader, often undertaking large and complex cases. He appears in the Crown Court, the Court of Appeal and the Administrative Court.

John recently led in a manslaughter case (*R v Hunt*, Central Criminal Court) and was himself led in a murder case (*R v Tracey*, Central Criminal Court).

He has also appeared in an international money laundering conspiracy, involving a loss of £2,500,00 (and some 11,000 pages of evidence), (*R v Hadley*, Middlesex Crown Court).

In 2005, he defended in a rape case (*R v Fontaine*, Liverpool Crown Court).

In 2006, he led in a VHCC three month historic abuse case at Norwich Crown Court in which the defendant was a headmaster (*R v Wilson*).

In 2007, John led in a multiple rape case involving historic abuse (*R v Pettit*) and has defended in a death by dangerous driving case.
